SCRIPTURES: READ and HIGHLIGHT them in your BIBLE

I SAY

God, I am ready for a holy intrusion – I'm ready for You to enter by force. I am open for an invasion - Holy Spirit come in. I am hungry for it and I pray for it. Holy Spirit, interrupt and stop all of my plans and have Your own way.

Looking Forward to God Invading

READ: Acts 4:29-33 (NKJV). God invaded the place. That is what I am looking forward to; God invading our services. I believe if we continue to hunger for it, it will become a commonplace. Manifestations of the presence of God only takes place when the church shows a holy unhappiness (dissatisfaction) with the way things are.

We must be willing to leave our comfort zone. Real Bible faith will not allow you to stay in a comfort zone because the nature of faith is to grow and increase. God promises signs, wonders and miracles for those who are willing to pay the price. Sometimes it means coming to church when you do not want to come, coming to prayer meetings when you do not feel like it and entering into praise and worship when you have had a horrible day.

I SAY

I have a holy unhappiness (dissatisfaction). I am not content (satisfied) with where I am currently. I break loose from spiritual laziness (lethargy). I am willing to leave my comfort zone because I want to see Your glory. I am willing to pray the glory down.

Stir Yourself Up

READ: Exodus 35:21 (NKJV). You stir yourself up. God is not going to do it for you. If you are waiting on God to stir you up, you've got a long wait.

READ: Isaiah 60:1-3 (NKJV). 'Arise, shine', implies that it is time that we stir ourselves up. If we will stir up ourselves, then God promises to increase (intensify) the glory. The Bible says that every one of them whose heart was stirred up, came. Those who were not stirred did not come. I am part of that group that is stirred. There are manifestations of God's goodness that none of us have even experienced yet. It is laid up, it is in reserve like a trust fund. He has been waiting for us to grow up to be able to use it. When we can show Him that we have reached a level of spiritual maturity, then get ready, the floodgates are opening. READ: Ephesians 6:18 (NKJV).

I SAY

READ: Psalms 31:19 (NKJV). I praise You for the goodness that You have laid up for me! How great is Your goodness that You have laid up for me because I fear You!

Spirit Rain, Being Humble & Pray

I truly believe that we have crossed a line (threshold) in God's timetable. He is ready to pour out His glory in the earth like we have never experienced before. New demonstrations of His power and the miraculous are awaiting us.

Some people in the church today have become so content with the way things are, but at the same time, there is an army of believers who have awakened, who have arisen, and they are no longer satisfied with the current situation. I do not know about you, but I am part of that group.

READ: Hosea 6:3 (NKJV). God promised that He shall come unto us as the rain, that means that there will be an outpouring of His presence that will cause a great reviving among His people. It will end, in the winning of many people to Christ because they will see our fire. Fire has a way of attracting. Our God is an all-consuming Fire. If you get close enough to Him, you will burn as well. You are not going to burn out, you will burn up.



HOLY INTRUSION

READ: 2 Chronicles 7:14 (NKJV). To humble ourselves means a willingness to submit to what God wants and desires. What does He desire? He wants us to pray. He wants us to ask Him for the rain. He wants us to ask Him to show us His glory. Nothing happens in the earth until God's people pray.

I SAY

I pray for a Holy Spirit invasion – for the Holy Spirit to move in. Lord, here I am, send me. I will be the intercessor - prayer. I will stand in the gap. Take me to a higher level of Your glory. Show me Your glory. I keep this on my lips and in my prayers. Revive me again. Cause me to flourish in my spirit. Revive me completely, Lord.

Don't Allow Anyone to Stop You

Do not allow anything or anyone to choke (stifle) your passion or your hunger for seeing the greater glory. God is going to honour your faithful commitment. We are not waiting on Him. He is waiting on us.
